

## I Know His Name

This one is a very old and misunderstood topic and perhaps this writing can help shed some light on the situation.

*You might want to research this for yourself since I am stating all this from memory by what I have studied over the years, along with some Scriptural references.*

There is a common misconception that everyone calls the Father in the shamayim (heaven) by the title or short name of "God". Where does that come from, and what established that to be the common calling of a higher power with no solid foundation to be so other than what is written in some sort of modified or otherwise so-called translated Scriptures?

Let's start with the very laws that state no one is allowed to speak His Name, but a Jewish high priest, and only on appointed high days of worship. This comes from the Jewish laws known as the Talmud, in existence before the Messiah came and was crucified, and rose again, and ascended to the Father.

Only a Jewish high priest is allowed to speak the Name of the Father and Creator? Well yes, that or you must be a Jew at the very least. The punishment for the crime of speaking His name and not being a Jewish high priest, or at the very least a Jew is death by beheading. This is also a law on the books in every country today from what I understand. It's part of what is called the Noahide laws, extracted from the Talmud I presume.

So, where does this title or short for a name called "God" come from, and why is it used instead of His Name in the Scriptures we read from? This is a very good question that many don't seem to ask about and just take it for granted that this is what He is supposed to be called by. Well let's start with the information above. If we are not supposed to be calling Him by His Name, the best way to keep us from doing that is by not telling us what His Name is, or making attempts to hide it so we cannot speak His Name.

This is a very interesting point, mentioning the attempt at hiding or keeping anyone who is not a

Jew from knowing the Name of the Father so they cannot speak it, much less call on Him by Name for help, praise and worship. If the Bible you use has replaced HIS NAME with the titles "God" and "Lord", it is perverted! It is meant to hide the Name of our Father and Creator so that we cannot know or speak His Name!

We already know that the false mighty one known as Satan, Lucifer, Beelzebub, or Gadre'el among many other names is the elohim (otherwise called "god") of this world as stated by Scripture, the NAMES are a key issue, and especially considering HIS name is clearly stated to not be taken in vain within the 10 commandments.

**(Shemoth) Exodus 20:7** Thou shalt not take the name of YHWH thy Elohim in vain; for YHWH will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

**(Yeshayahu) Isaiah 42:8** I am YHWH: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.

The thing that needs to be understood here is the perversion of the Scriptures in order to hide the Names of both the Father and Messiah, replacing them with what seems to be titles or names of other false mighty ones, and in actuality, they are calling on those false mighty ones by their names or references to their names.

This seems to be the "other evangel and other ha'Mashiach (Messiah)" that Paul warned about and cursed twice. The perverted Scriptures!

**(Galatiyim) Galatians Gal 1:6** I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the favour of the Messiah unto another evangel: **7** Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the glad tidings of the Messiah. **8** But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other evangel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. **9** As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other evangel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

Ok, so what is His Name? We saw it mentioned when the Scriptures without the perversion that removed his Name was used above. The Name of the Father translated directly from Hebrew to English is YHWH, which is pronounced as Yahuwah. In Hebrew there are no vowels in the letters, so that is why the translation to English looks like it does. To better understand how the vowels are implicated, is to understand the Hebrew letters.

His name in Hebrew is  and that is spelled from right to left as yod hey waw hey. From the pronunciation of those letters you might get a glimpse of the implied sound those letters produce, but that can change slightly depending on what letters they are combined with as you see here. Those four Paleo Hebrew letters is what makes the English translation become YHWH. Paleo Hebrew is a version of Hebrew used during the time of the semantic people of that time period. Here is a quick one for you. HalleluYah is a word they forgot to remove. That word means Praise You Yah or praise to Yah, using the short version of His Name as Yah!

Ok, so where does the title or name “God” come from? That is an even more interesting question! There is no hint at all from within the canonized Scriptures we were given by the Council of Nicea, but we can find from another book that the Scriptures give reference to twice. The book of (Hanok) Enoch! It is in the book of Hanok where we find the one who walked with Yah (short for Yahuwah), and was so loved by Yah that Yahuwah took him, instead of letting him taste of death. We should think that any writings of Hanock would be considered extremely important!

It is within the book of Hanok we find where he gives the name of the third chief messenger or what some may call an angel or devil, the very same one who tempted (Hawwah) Eve, as Gadre’el. Remember how we saw that Yah is short for Yahuwah? Guess what Gad or God as it is pronounced is short for? Yup, you guessed it, the “god” of this world, Gadre’el! Now who or why would someone use that in place of the true name of the Father, being Yah or Yahuwah? Who perverted the Scriptures to lead man astray? Isn’t it said that if the blind lead the blind won’t they both fall into the ditch? Interesting!

Ok, you may have something there with “God” being used in place of YHWH. What about Lord? We saw you mentioned if the title Lord was used in place of His Name it is a perverted Scripture too. This one is rather easy to explain because the canonized Scripture itself reveals the truth.

**(Yirmeyahu) Jeremiah 23:27** Which think to cause my people to forget my name by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal.

You might want to read the entire chapters of Yirmeyahu 23 though 25 to see what these so called pastors, priests and prophets were doing.

We can see this happening in the old covenant and the new covenant as well.

**(Romiyim) Romans 2:24** For the name of YHWH is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written.

This shows that the so-called rabbis or teachers or priests of that time were intentionally causing non-Jews to blaspheme against Yah. This links directly to their Jewish laws, the Talmud! Apparently they were telling the non-Jewish community to call him by Lord. Lord is a title for master, and who was the first “master” or mighty one of the people who were not following Yah? Ba’al! This is an outright breaking of the commandment of taking His Name in vain found in the 10 commandments!

Here’s the good news, we have truths to find and ways to deliver His message!

**(Romiyim) Rom 10:13** For whosoever shall call upon the name of YHWH shall be saved. **14** How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in

him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

We are the ones to speak of this and tell the truth to those who do not know or understand. We are the ones that Yeshayahu spoke of!

**(Yeshayahu) Isaiah 58:12** And they that shall be of thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach, The restorer of paths to dwell in.

There is more to being a “repairer of the breach” than just revealing His Name, and the true Name of the Messiah, which is not Jesus! That is a name referring to Iesous, the Greek mighty one known as Zeus, and apparently slipped in with the Greek translations of Hebrew. In fact, the letter J did not even exist but for the last 500 years, making it impossible for that to be the name above all names, the one name whereby man must be saved.

The real name of the Messiah in Hebrew is spelled from right to left as yod, hey, waw, shin, ayin and looks like this:  The English translation of that is Yahushua. This is the real Name that is above all names, whereby all man must be saved.

This is how those Scriptures really read...

**(Romiyim) Rom 10:9** That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth that Yahushua is the Messiah, and shalt believe in thine heart that YHWH hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

**(Ma’aseh) Acts 4:10** Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Yahushua the Messiah of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom YHWH raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. **11** This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. **12** Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

The rest of restoring the paths to dwell in as being a repairer of the breach and the paths to dwell in is in following the Scriptural calendar to find the true Sabbath and Feasts of Yah, and being a witness to His truth and salvation given to us by ha’Mashiach Yahushua!

Word of warning... we should not speak the names of the false mighty ones, as we are told not to!

**(Shemoth) Exodus 23:13** And in all things that I have said unto you be circumspect: and make no mention of the name of other elohim, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth.

**(Yahoshua) Joshua 23:7** That ye come not among these nations, these that remain among you; neither make mention of the name of their elohim, nor cause to swear [by them], neither serve them, nor bow yourselves unto them:

**(Tehillim) Psalms 16:4** Their sorrows shall be multiplied that hasten after another elohim: their drink offerings of blood will I not offer, nor take up their names into my lips.
