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CHAPTER ONE
LEARNING TO LOVE

“Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Yahushua the Messiah is in you, except ye be reprobates?” - 2 Cor. 13:5

Let us examine ourselves both individually, and as a part of the body of the assembly of Yahushua. Are we, both separately and together, living to the fullness of that which our Father in heaven has called us to? Many of us claim to love Yahuwah, or try to love Yahuwah with all that we are, and believe, but is this acceptable in Yahs’ eyes? We must look beyond our own ideas or understanding to the Word of Yah, wholly seeking to know the truth. To want to serve Him is just the beginning, to really love YHWH. To even begin to love Yah, we must realize that we are sinners that need to repent of our own ways. We need to ask the Messiah Yahushua to come into our heart, and make Him the center of our lives. We also need to receive the gift of the set-apart Spirit into our lives, to be our help in guidance to the things of Yahuwah. Without Yahushua, and the set-apart Spirit in our lives, I believe, it is impossible to love Yah in the way that He wants, and deserves.

Proverbs 14:12; “There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.” Man, in himself, cannot please Yah. Mans’ own understanding, without Yahushua, and the set-apart Spirit to guide him, cannot know, or bear the things of Yahuwah. In man’s own wisdom is found the ideas that the world wants him to know. **1 Cor.3:9-20; “For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with YHWH. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness. And again, YHWH knoweth the thoughts of the wise, that they are vain.”** This world, nor the people of this world’s ways can truly love Yahuwah.

Paul, in his first letter to the Corinthians, chapter two, tells us that this world does not know Yahuwah, or the things of Yah, because they are spiritually discerned. The Spirit of Yahuwah teaches us the things of Yahuwah. **1 Cor. 2:5-14; “That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of YHWH. Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought: But we speak the wisdom of YHWH in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which YHWH ordained before the world unto our glory:**

Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the King of glory. But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which Elohim hath prepared for them that love him. But YHWH hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of YHWH. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of Elohim knoweth no man, but the Spirit of Elohim. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of Elohim; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of YHWH. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Set-apart Spirit teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of YHWH: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. “

We see in this passage of scripture, as with all scripture, that the things of Yahuwah are on a higher ground than the things of man. Therefore, we cannot attain them of ourselves, we need the set-apart Spirit of Yah to take us into that holy ground. We need to know the truth, and the only way we can get to the truth, and get it into our heart, is by the set-apart Spirit. We have to become spiritually minded, with the set-apart Spirit, to receive the things of Yahuwah. It is our nature to rebel against Yah, and His wisdom, because we cannot understand it of ourselves. Some people seem to view Him as a stern Elohim, shaking His finger at them, telling them what they can't do. In actuality, He is revealing His infinite love for us, just like a father would for his child. The law of Yah is for our sake, not for His own. It is the foundation of what is required of us, in order to be with Him. It is something that has to be spiritually discerned to understand.

Romans 8:4-10; “That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity against YHWH: for it is not subject to the law of YHWH, neither indeed can be. So then they that are in the flesh cannot please YHWH. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of YHWH dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of the Messiah, he is none of his. And if the Messiah be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.” We have to become spiritually minded in order to find the truth concerning all things. No one can become spiritually minded of themselves. They have to become influenced, whether it be of this world, or it be of Yahuwah. This world will not, and cannot lead you to the truth, and that includes all that is within it. This world is full of darkness, and the Word of Yahuwah is the light that shines in the midst of the darkness. To see the light is one thing, but without guidance, it is as a flash of light from a camera. It will shine on you for a while, but then returns to where it came from. To follow the light, we have to have guidance to be in the light when it returns to where it goes, otherwise we remain in darkness.

John 16:13-15; “Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you. All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you.” The set-apart Spirit will come upon us when we ask Yah for the set-apart Spirit, to baptize us in the power of the set-apart Spirit. We must ask of a sincere heart when we pray to Yahuwah, to receive what we pray for. He that asks of Yahuwah with no doubt in his heart, will receive what

he asks, as long as it is Yah's will. Yahuwah has assured us He will give the set-apart Spirit to those that ask Him, it is written in the Word of Yahuwah. The work of the set-apart Spirit is to guide us in wisdom, understanding, counsel, might, knowledge, and the fear of Yahuwah. There are also gifts given to us by the set-apart Spirit that we might have a greater advantage over the works of evil, and advance in the kingdom of Yah. We need to find out what gifts that we may have, and put them to use when we receive them.

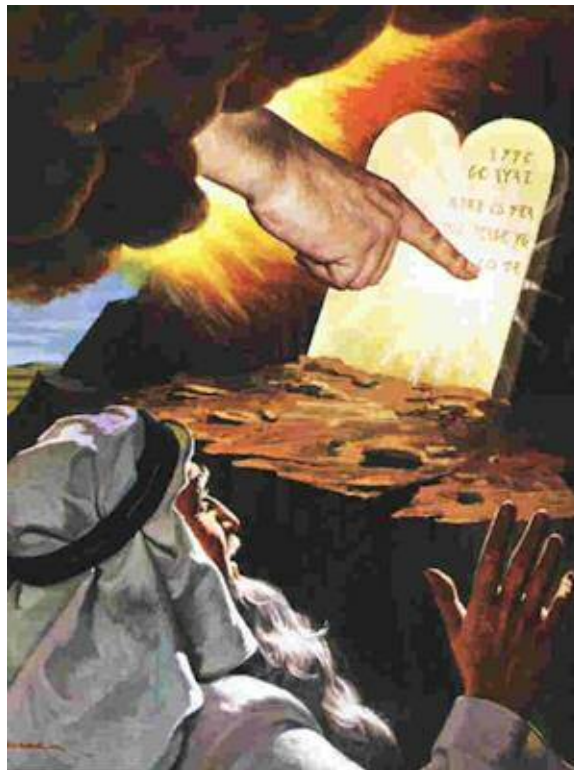
Isaiah 11:2-5; "And the spirit of YHWH shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of YHWH; And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of YHWH: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears: But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked. And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins." It is necessary to the believer, to have the set-apart Spirit in their lives. Without the Spirit of Yahuwah, the believer will be like the seeds that are cast by the wayside, in stony places, and among thorns; they will become stagnant and die, or the thorny plants will kill them. The set-part Spirit has a part in the work to be done in this world, to bring forth light, and we need to be willing vessels of His work. The set-part Spirit will also reprove the the world of sin, and of righteousness. He will bear witness to the things of Yahuwah, and expose the sinful ways of man, and this world. **John 16:7-11; "Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged."**

All of this brings us to the Law of Yahuwah. We must understand that the Law of Yah is not the law of this world, nor the law of the flesh. Yah's Law is a spiritual law, and cannot be lived any other way than by the guidance, and power of the set-apart Spirit in our lives. **Rom. 8:1-4; "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in the Messiah Yahushua, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Messiah Yahushua hath made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, YHWH sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.** The keeping of His Law expresses our love to Yahuwah. The Law of Yahuwah is an extension of His love for us, and by our keeping it, we express our love to Him. Yahshua said; **"If ye love me, keep my commandments."** -**John 14:21**, and He goes further to say in **John 14:21; "He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him."** This is the way that Yahuwah views your love for Him, this is the true love for Yah, that we keep His commandments.

This is the fulfillment of the greatest commandment that Yahuwah has put to us; to keep His commandments. **Matt. 22:36-38; "Rabbi, which is the great commandment in the law? Yahushua said unto him, Thou shalt love YHWH thy Elohim with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment."** Yahuwah will test us to know whether or not we love Him with all our heart and soul, and He does test us, to know if we really do love Him.

Deut. 13:1-5; “If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and giveth thee a sign or a wonder, And the sign or the wonder come to pass, whereof he spake unto thee, saying, Let us go after other elohim, which thou hast not known, and let us serve them; Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for YHWH your Elohim proveth you, to know whether ye love YHWH your Elohim with all your heart and with all your soul. Ye shall walk after YHWH your Elohim, and fear him, and keep his commandments, and obey his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him. And that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams, shall be put to death; because he hath spoken to turn you away from YHWH your Elohim, which brought you out of the land of Egypt, and redeemed you out of the house of bondage, to thrust thee out of the way which YHWH thy Elohim commanded thee to walk in. So shalt thou put the evil away from the midst of thee.”

In verses three and four above are the verses that state how Yahuwah will test our love for Him. Do we keep His commandments? Are we fulfilling the love which Yah has called us to? If we wish to be with Yahuwah, we need to evaluate ourselves, and do that which our heavenly Father has called us to. We need to become spiritually minded, with the set-apart Spirit of Yah, and learn of His truths.



CHAPTER TWO THE TEN COMMANMENTS

Exodus 20:2-17 “I am YHWH thy Elohim, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. Thou shalt have no other elohim before me.

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I YHWH thy Elohim am a jealous Elohim, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. Thou shalt not take the name of YHWH thy Elohim in vain; for YHWH will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it set-apart. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the Sabbath of YHWH thy Elohim: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days YHWH made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore YHWH blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which YHWH thy Elohim giveth thee. Thou shalt not murder. Thou shalt not commit adultery. Thou shalt not steal. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's."

First of all, to clear something up to which you might notice from the quote above is a correction of scriptural translation or transliteration. What is known as "thou shalt not kill" is an incorrect translation or transliteration of the scriptures, where kill was put in place of what should be shown as murder. To kill and murder are two different things. To kill is with just cause or reason, where to murder is without just cause or reason. Perhaps this will answer your question as to why Yahuwah permitted that some be killed in order to uphold His Laws and Commandments. These are the ten commandments of Yahuwah. We are to keep them, without reserve, with the aid of the set-apart Spirit in our lives. This is our love to Yahuwah. This is the only one thing that Yah put His very own hand to, in the writing of the commandments, to be given to us by Moses. **Exodus. 31:18; "And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of Elohim."** When Yahuwah, the Father, personally involves Himself to something, we should be careful to give it much attention, for it is of great importance to Him, and to us. **1 John 2:3-5; "And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of YHWH perfected: hereby know we that we are in him."** This is how we may know who the children of Yahuwah are, and those who need to know Him, and that we ourselves truly know Him. **1 John 5:2-3; "By this we know that we love the children of YHWH, when we love YHWH, and keep his commandments. For this is the love of YHWH, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous."**

As Yahuwah's kingdom shall stand forever, so will His Law, and His Word. One is part of the other, and they are inseparable. Yahuwah and His Law are perfect, they have no need for change. **Heb. 13:8; "Yahushua the Messiah the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever."** Shows us that Yahushua, the Son of Yahuwah, and our Messiah does not change either. This basically tells us that Yahuwah, His Son, and Word do not change. This includes His Laws, His Ways, and His days. To get a clearer understanding of this, we need to see the eternal connection between Yah and His Law. The tables of the Law were kept in the Ark of the Covenant, in the holy of holies of the tabernacle, or sanctuary of YHWH, in the days of that time

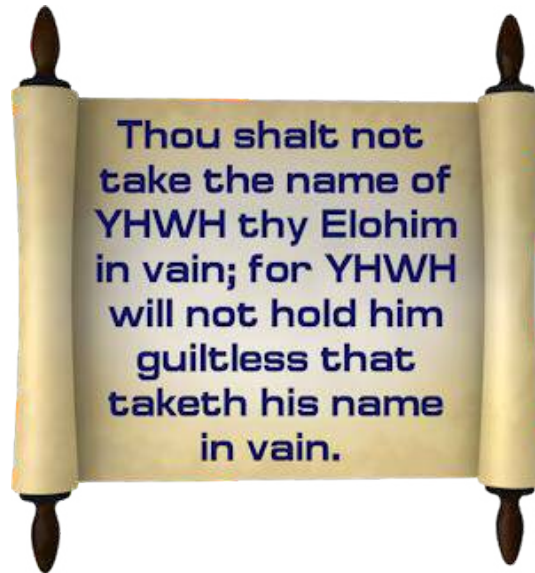
on earth. The glory, or presence of Yahuwah remained above the Ark in the holy of holies. The Ark of the Covenant, and its' content is a most sacred thing of Yahuwah, that has remained among men for a time on earth. The men who even dared to touch it died a sudden death. Understand this, all that is inside the ark are the two tables of stone - the Ten Commandments of Yahuwah. **1 Kgs. 8:9; "There was nothing in the ark save the two tables of stone, which Moses put there at Horeb, when YHWH made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt."** The Law of YHWH ever remains before His presence. Where we find the Law of Yahuwah, we find Him. The mercy of Yahuwah is the one and only thing that is found between Yahuwah and His Law. **Exo. 25:21-22; "And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee. And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel."**

The mercy seat represents the only thing that Yahuwah has between Him and His Law, and that is His mercy for those that love Him. We see in verse 22, that that is where He will meet with us, (At least until Yahushua lifts up off of the mercy seat from the right hand of the Father to return to the earth at His second coming), and where He shall remain. All mercy comes forth from Yahuwah, for He is the Father of mercy. **2 Cor. 1:3-4; "Blessed be YHWH, even the Father of our Master Yahushua the Messiah, the Father of mercies, and the Elohim of all comfort; Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of Elohim."**

In the time we live now, the Ark of the Covenant *and* the presence of Yahuwah and His mercy are no longer on earth, in a *man-made* tabernacle. They are in heaven, where they shall remain until such time as when the Kingdom of Yahuwah, and the New Jerusalem rests on earth for eternity. **Psalms. 36:5; "Thy mercy, O YHWH, is in the heavens; and thy faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds."** Therefore, we cannot attain the righteousness of the Law, except spiritually, through the set-apart Spirit and Yahushua, our Messiah. **1 Kings 8:30 "Thy mercy, O YHWH, is in the heavens; and thy faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds."** Our prayers to Yah, through the set-apart Spirit and Yahushua, are heard in the holy of holies in heaven. Yahushua goes before Yah's presence' on our behalf, with our petitions to Yahuwah. We have much to be thankful for in our Messiah, and the mercy of Yahuwah. **Heb. 9:24-26; "For the Messiah is not entered into the set-apart places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of YHWH for us: Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the set-apart place every year with blood of others; For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself."**

The commandments of YHWH ought to receive more attention than they do in these days. There is a force working against this, and has been since the days of old. We will see the works of evil exposed in the chapters ahead. We need to remember that Yahuwah does not change, and that includes His Son and our Messiah, Yahushua, His Law, His Ways, and His Days, which stand forever. Furthermore, all people are to keep His commandments, His Ways, and His Days, or choose the way which leads to death. **Mal. 3:6; "For I am YHWH, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed."** **Psalms 119:152; "Concerning thy testimonies, I have known of old that thou hast founded them for ever."** One special note, in that even the angels of heaven keep, and do the commandments of Yahuwah. **Psalms 103:20;**

“Bless YHWH, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.”



CHAPTER THREE
THE THIRD COMMANDMENT

Exodus 20:7; “Thou shalt not take the name of YHWH thy Elohim in vain; for YHWH will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.”

This is probably one of the most misunderstood commandments in our day and time for several reasons. Another translation of this scripture might be a bit more revealing. The following is from the Halleluyah Scriptures, a set of scriptures restored from the Restored King James version, and then taken a step further for more accurate translation and the removal of names and titles that stem from pagan origin. **Exodus 20:7; “You do not bring the Name of ^{יהוה} your Elohim to naught, for ^{יהוה} does not leave the one unpunished who brings His Name to naught.”** Naught, guess what that means. According to the Mirriam-Webster Dictionary; Definition of NAUGHT: nothing <efforts came to *naught*>. So in other words, bring His name to mean nothing.

Now comes the big question. Do you really know His name? I’ve been using it quite often in the first two chapters. What you see above in the scripture quote from the Halleluyah Scriptures in reference to His Name is the actual Paleo Hebrew spelling of His Name, when transliterated means YHWH, or it is pronounced as Yahuwah. Many of those that seek Him only know Him by the TITLES given to them by the Biblical translation they have, and not by His Name. His Name is not God, or Lord, as those are simply titles which when they are corrected are meaning Elohim and Master. The title “god” is in reference to other false mighty ones, and capitalizing it does nothing, because that title still comes from a title created in pagan origin. Basically all you are doing is calling on the “God of the gods”, and there is only one “God of the gods” for this world, be it the “God” of this world, which we already know is Lucifer, or the “God of the gods” for the Greek, which is Zeus. Now try saying that name you know as your Savior, Jesus, in the Spanish language and you will hear who you are calling on, as it sounds exactly like “hey-Zeus”. More explaining where these use of titles and names came from later in this chapter, but first, let’s take a look at what the Word of Yahuwah says about this.

To start this off, let's bring your attention to the word HalleluYah, which is a correct transliteration of the word from Paleo Hebrew to English. Paleo Hebrew is what the first covenant was written in, and is the *preferred* translation that all scripture should be transliterated or translated from, not Greek (more about this later). This word HalleluYah bears the name of the Father, because it's not just a single word. Translated, it means "praise you Yah" or "praise to Yah" Now, how is it possible we could have missed that? Deception is the oldest trick in the book, and was the *first* means used by Satan to cause man to commit sin. The *creeping deception* that has entered into minds and hearts of people is what has caused them to fall away from the truth, and adhere to false doctrines, and the commandments of men, rather than that which is truth from the Word of Yahuwah. Part of that can directly be attributed to the Greek transliteration or translation of the original language, which was Paleo Hebrew. It's not that hard to figure out when you realize the "God of gods" for the Greek is Zeus, and you really begin to look at the transliterated or translated meaning differences between Paleo Hebrew and Greek as shown in Strong's Concordance or otherwise.

In Paleo Hebrew, all names have a meaning, but when translated or transliterated to Greek that is not always so, as Greek names don't always have a meaning to the name. This is one of the first clues to look at when you start looking for the *meaning of the names* as used by the Greek. One other thing to consider is the fact that the Jews spoke Hebrew, and not Greek for the most part, including all 12 of the disciples, as most were unlearned in Greek, being simple fishermen and such. Even Paul had a problem trying to speak Greek, much less try to write it. Take the time for yourself to really search the Paleo Hebrew language to find the truth of what was written, not just for the 1st Covenant, but also the second, and then you will gain better understanding, or make it simple for yourself and get the HalleluYah Scriptures, or at the very least, the Restored Kind James version. I use them both, as I cannot seem to find the HalleluYah Scriptures in digital format for my digital Bibles as a reference. I think that has something to do with "copyright issues", but who owns the "copyright" to the Word of Yahuwah? Yahuwah only. He has also stated within His Word, freely as you receive, freely give. That is another reason this document, or book is not allowed to be sold, and may only be given free of charge.

So, now we have seen there is a names and tiles problem at the very least in the Greek rendition of the Second Covenant, but where or why were the names changed? First, let's look into the scriptures themselves...

Exodus 3:15 "And Elohim said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, YHWH Elohim of your fathers, the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations."

Exodus 23:13 "And in all things that I have said unto you be circumspect: and make no mention of the name of other elohim, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth."

Lev 19:12 "And ye shall not swear by my name falsely, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy Elohim: I am YHWH."

Lev 22:2 "Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, that they separate themselves from the set-apart things of the children of Israel, and that they profane not my set-apart name in those things which they hallow unto me: I am YHWH."

Deut 18:20 "But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other elohim, even that prophet shall die."

Joshua 23:6-7 “Be ye therefore very courageous to keep and to do all that is written in the book of the law of Moses, that ye turn not aside therefrom [to] the right hand or [to] the left; That ye come not among these nations, these that remain among you; neither make mention of the name of their elohim, nor cause to swear [by them], neither serve them, nor bow yourselves unto them:”

Isaiah 8:11-20 “For YHWH spake thus to me with a strong hand, and instructed me that I should not walk in the way of this people, saying, Say ye not, A confederacy, to all them to whom this people shall say, A confederacy; neither fear ye their fear, nor be afraid. Sanctify YHWH of hosts himself; and let him be your fear, and let him be your dread. And he shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. And many among them shall stumble, and fall, and be broken, and be snared, and be taken. Bind up the testimony, seal the law among my disciples. And I will wait upon YHWH, that hideth his face from the house of Jacob, and I will look for him. Behold, I and the children whom YHWH hath given me are for signs and for wonders in Israel from YHWH of hosts, which dwelleth in mount Zion. And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their Elohim? for the living to the dead? To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.”

Isaiah 44:6 “Thus saith YHWH the King of Israel, and his redeemer YHWH of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no Elohim.”

Isaiah 48:8-11 “Yea, thou heardest not; yea, thou knewest not; yea, from that time that thine ear was not opened: for I knew that thou wouldest deal very treacherously, and wast called a transgressor from the womb. For my name's sake will I defer mine anger, and for my praise will I refrain for thee, that I cut thee not off. Behold, I have refined thee, but not with silver; I have chosen thee in the furnace of affliction. For mine own sake, even for mine own sake, will I do it: for how should my name be polluted? and I will not give my glory unto another.”

Isaiah 52:5 “Now therefore, what have I here, saith YHWH, that my people is taken away for nought? they that rule over them make them to howl, saith YHWH; and my name continually every day is blasphemed.”

Jeremiah 16:21 “Therefore, behold, I will this once cause them to know, I will cause them to know mine hand and my might; and they shall know that my name is YHWH.”

Jeremiah 23:5-6 “Behold, the days come, saith YHWH, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth. In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, YHWH OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.”

Jeremiah 23:20-27 “The anger of YHWH shall not return, until he have executed, and till he have performed the thoughts of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it perfectly. I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran: I have not spoken to them, yet they prophesied. But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings. Am I an Elohim at hand, saith YHWH,

and not an Elohim afar off? Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith YHWH. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith YHWH. I have heard what the prophets said, that prophesy lies in my name, saying, I have dreamed, I have dreamed. How long shall this be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? yea, they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart; Which think to cause my people to forget my name by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal.”

Hosea 2:16-17 “And it shall be at that day, saith YHWH, that thou shalt call me Ishi; and shalt call me no more Baali. For I will take away the names of Baalim out of her mouth, and they shall no more be remembered by their name.”

Zecharaiah 13:8-9 “And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, saith YHWH, two parts therein shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left therein. And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: I will say, It is my people: and they shall say, YHWH is my Elohim.”

Psalms 44:20-21 “If we have forgotten the name of our Elohim, or stretched out our hands to a strange el; Shall not Elohim search this out? for he knoweth the secrets of the heart.”

Proverbs. 30:4 “Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?”

Romans 2:24 “For the name of YHWH is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written.”

Romans 9:17 “For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.”

Now I could go on and on about what Yah says about His Name, and even what Yahushua says about the Name of the Father, and even His own name, but I think after just these many different biblical scripture quotes you can get the general picture. The ironic thing here is the Proverbs 30:4 and Romans 2:24 quotes I listed as they point to something that has been going on for a very long time. The religious leaders of the Jews, otherwise known as the Sanhedrin has a specific “rule” or “commandment of men” in their religious rule book, which is known as the Talmud. Only the High Priests were allowed to speak the name of Yahuwah, and only at high religious days they observed, within the sanctuary. They went even farther with this rule that only Jews were allowed to speak the name of Yahuwah, or suffer punishment by death. That rule still exists, and is part of the noahide laws, which are a set of laws that appear to attempt to replace the Ten Commandments of Yahuwah with only 7 laws or rules. Part of that also seems to include the idea that only Jews are allowed to study Torah. The noahide laws are actually on the books in many countries already, but not yet being strictly enforced, but likely to start being enforced sometime in the near future, for those who know how to read the signs of the times.

This is the deception that has been done, in that in most versions of the Word of YHWH, the very name of Yahuwah or YHWH has been *replaced* with titles such as “God”, and Lord because they claim the Name of Yahuwah is too sacred to be spoken except by High Priests at high religious times within the sanctuary, or at the very least, by Jews only. This is why most people

only seem to think of His name as “God”, Lord, or I AM. As you can see from the quotes above, He very clearly states what His name is, and that is His name forever, and that Name is YHWH, which is pronounced as Yahuwah.

Now this may be somewhat controversial, but looking in the book of Enoch, we find that the name of the third devil, which is also appearing to be Satan himself, has another name not commonly known... Gadreel. Just like we might say the name of Yah in short for Yahuwah, the name of Gad in short for Gadreel sounds exactly like the “title” we know as “God”. What was mentioned before? Who’s the “God” of this world? In like manner, the mention of Jesus sounding like “hey-zeus”, we find that the Greek translation or transliteration of that name in the original KJV 1611 is Iesous, which according to a recent Google search, reveals that as meaning “healing zeus” (Jesus, and Iesous) which are pagan in origin, and literally translated means “Hail Zeus”. Keep in mind that the letter J has only existed for approximately 400 years, and that is definitely not old enough to be part of the real name of our Messiah, translation or transliteration aside. Besides, when is the last time you saw anyone of great importance have his name spoken differently or translated to the language of another country?

Here’s something else to take note of, in that along with the Paleo Hebrew names having meaning to them, many also had the name Yah in their name, or a variation of that such as the name El, and Shua. Many of the names we know today that have been transliterated or translated were actually names bearing parts of His name, or like-minded meanings. Just to name a few and their meanings; Joshua=Yahoshua (Yah is Salvation), Samuel=Shemuel (Heard of El), Isaiah=Yeshayahu (Salvation of Yah), Jeremiah=Yiremeyahu (Exultation of Yah), Ezekiel=Yehezqel (Strength of El), Daniel (Judgement of El), Hosea=Hoshea (Salvation), Obadiah=Obadyah (Servant of Yah). I am with the hope when I am given my new name it will be of such magnitude as these, bearing His name within mine. For even as Yahuwah is in Yahushua, and Yahushua is in Yahuwah, I desire to be the same as a brother to Yahushua in His Kingdom, within the family of Yah, and His child.

If you really want to know Him, and the truth, you have to do the research yourself, and seek Him for yourself. Do not trust what me or anyone else tells you, but only His way, which is to reprove all things according to His Word, and make sure that it is *really* His Word, and not some messed up translation or transliteration. We are only the messengers, pointing the way. It is you who has to choose to receive the light given or reject it. If you truly seek to know Him, the set-apart Spirit of Yahuwah will reveal to you as it is according to the will of Yahuwah. You will know what the truth really is as it is given and reprovved according to His Word. I personally believe this is part of the final message to be given during these last days as the times of great trouble in the world unfolds.



CHAPTER FOUR THE FOURTH COMMANDMENT

Exodus 20:8-11; “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it set-apart. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the Sabbath of YHWH thy Elohim: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days YHWH made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore YHWH blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.”

Brothers and sisters, this, the fourth commandment, is another one of the most denied, ignored, and broken commandment of all commandments by the people in the world today. Not just the sinners, but the church, which is known as the assembly of Yahushua, also bears witness against itself, that it does not keep the commandments of Yahuwah. It's not the entire assembly, but the ones who seek Him, but do not have the full understanding. Some even teach against the keeping of the Sabbath, saying that it was part of the Old Covenant that was nailed to the stake with Yahushua at Calvary, and that it is no longer to be observed. This is a false doctrine that has been incorporated, and handed down from church to church. It is simply another *creeping compromise* that is so commonly taught that no one seems to question it. That could be the very thing upon which could destroy them; the lack of knowledge. We shall see the truth of this matter in the pages ahead.

First, let's look at an example of Sabbath keeping. Take notice, that this took place even before the writing of the Ten Commandments upon the two tables of stone at Mount Sinai. **Exodus 16:1-30; “And they took their journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the wilderness of Sin, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after their departing out of the land of Egypt. And the whole congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness: And the children of Israel said unto them,**

Would to Elohim we had died by the hand of YHWH in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the flesh pots, and when we did eat bread to the full; for ye have brought us forth into this wilderness, to kill this whole assembly with hunger. Then said YHWH unto Moses, Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you; and the people shall go out and gather a certain rate every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in my law, or no. And it shall come to pass, that on the sixth day they shall prepare that which they bring in; and it shall be twice as much as they gather daily.

And Moses and Aaron said unto all the children of Israel, At even, then ye shall know that YHWH hath brought you out from the land of Egypt: And in the morning, then ye shall see the glory of YHWH; for that he heareth your murmurings against YHWH: and what are we, that ye murmur against us? And Moses said, This shall be, when YHWH shall give you in the evening flesh to eat, and in the morning bread to the full; for that YHWH heareth your murmurings which ye murmur against him: and what are we? your murmurings are not against us, but against YHWH. And Moses spake unto Aaron, Say unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, Come near before YHWH: for he hath heard your murmurings. And it came to pass, as Aaron spake unto the whole congregation of the children of Israel, that they looked toward the wilderness, and, behold, the glory of YHWH appeared in the cloud.

And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel: speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread; and ye shall know that I am YHWH your Elohim. And it came to pass, that at even the quails came up, and covered the camp: and in the morning the dew lay round about the host. And when the dew that lay was gone up, behold, upon the face of the wilderness there lay a small round thing, as small as the hoar frost on the ground. And when the children of Israel saw it, they said one to another, It is manna: for they knew not what it was. And Moses said unto them, This is the bread which YHWH hath given you to eat. This is the thing which YHWH hath commanded, Gather of it every man according to his eating, an omer for every man, according to the number of your persons; take ye every man for them which are in his tents. And the children of Israel did so, and gathered, some more, some less. And when they did mete it with an omer, he that gathered much had nothing over, and he that gathered little had no lack; they gathered every man according to his eating. And Moses said, Let no man leave of it till the morning. Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto Moses; but some of them left of it until the morning, and it bred worms, and stank: and Moses was wroth with them. And they gathered it every morning, every man according to his eating: and when the sun waxed hot, it melted.

And it came to pass, that on the sixth day they gathered twice as much bread, two omers for one man: and all the rulers of the congregation came and told Moses. And he said unto them, This is that which YHWH hath said, To morrow is the rest of the set-apart Sabbath unto YHWH: bake that which ye will bake to day, and seethe that ye will seethe; and that which remaineth over lay up for you to be kept until the morning. And they laid it up till the morning, as Moses bade: and it did not stink, neither was there any worm therein. And Moses said, Eat that to day; for to day is a Sabbath unto YHWH: to day ye shall not find it in the field. Six days ye shall gather it; but on the seventh day, which is the Sabbath, in it there shall be none. And it came to pass, that there went out some of the people on the seventh

day for to gather, and they found none. And YHWH said unto Moses, How long refuse ye to keep my commandments and my laws? See, for that YHWH hath given you the Sabbath, therefore he giveth you on the sixth day the bread of two days; abide ye every man in his place, let no man go out of his place on the seventh day. So the people rested on the seventh day.”

This commandment has been in existence since the world began. We can read in the book of Genesis, after Yahuwah created all that He created, He rested, and set this law into motion. In the passage that we have just read above, we can get a glimpse of how serious He is about His Law, and the fourth commandment specifically. This passage is just one of the many examples of Sabbath observance that we can read about in His Word. There is a great deal of scripture that centers upon the fourth commandment. To all people reading this, especially those who profess to have the set-apart Spirit of Yahuwah in their lives; hear what the set-apart Spirit of Yahuwah says to you, and to your heart. Find this Sabbath, the seventh day of rest, and meet with Him with prayer, praise and worship at His Appointed time. He is there for you, so you should be there for Him too. This is our love with Yahuwah.

Isaiah 56:1-7; “Thus saith YHWH, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for my salvation is near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed. Blessed is the man that doeth this, and the son of man that layeth hold on it; that keepeth the Sabbath from polluting it, and keepeth his hand from doing any evil. Neither let the son of the stranger, that hath joined himself to YHWH, speak, saying, YHWH hath utterly separated me from his people: neither let the eunuch say, Behold, I am a dry tree. For thus saith YHWH unto the eunuchs that keep my Sabbaths, and choose the things that please me, and take hold of my covenant; Even unto them will I give in mine house and within my walls a place and a name better than of sons and of daughters: I will give them an everlasting name, that shall not be cut off. Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to YHWH, to serve him, and to love the name of YHWH, to be his servants, every one that keepeth the Sabbath from polluting it, and taketh hold of my covenant; Even them will I bring to my set-apart mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices shall be accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people.”

I want to point out from what we see above that it is made clear that this is not just for the Jews, but for all people. No one is left out, as His love is for all. Then it is taken a step farther as written in **Isaiah 66:22-23; “For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith YHWH, so shall your seed and your name remain. And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith YHWH.”** We see here that the Sabbath will be observed even in the new heavens and the new Earth, where upon the New Jerusalem will be, but it also tells us how to find the Sabbath too when it speaks of one new moon to another. This will be discussed in another chapter later, because this is one of several of His Appointed Times. There is one special thing about the Sabbath, in that it remains to be a sign between Yah, and His people. This is also another reason why the Sabbath is so unique and important. It is a spiritual sign to the believer, and a physical sign to the unbeliever.

We see a mention of this sign in **Exodus 31:12-18; “And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my Sabbaths ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that**

ye may know that I am YHWH that doth sanctify you. Ye shall keep the Sabbath therefore; for it is set-apart unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth any work therein, that soul shall be cut off from among his people. Six days may work be done; but in the seventh is the Sabbath of rest, set-apart to YHWH: whosoever doeth any work in the Sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death. Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the Sabbath, to observe the Sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant. It is a sign between me and the children of Israel for ever: for in six days YHWH made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day he rested, and was refreshed. And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of Elohim.”

To the unbeliever, those who believe not on the Law of YHWH, it is strange to them, that we follow after the fourth commandment, and the Law of Yah. We, indeed, are set apart as a peculiar people, because we do not fit into the “common religion” of this world. The unbeliever has, or choseth to have no understanding of the Law of Yahuwah to the measure necessary to please Yah. **Hos. 8:12; “I have written to him the great things of my law, but they were counted as a strange thing.”** Some may gain understanding of the Law, and decide not to walk in the Law because of inconvenience to them, choosing to remain in the ways they have known, and claim that the Law is void, or not for them. Understand this, they speak of their own wisdom, or the world’s wisdom. In time, they even try to put those that speak the Law away from them, that they might not be reminded of the decisions they have made.

Nehemiah 9:26; “Nevertheless they were disobedient, and rebelled against thee, and cast thy law behind their backs, and slew thy prophets which testified against them to turn them to thee, and they wrought great provocations.” They do these such things that they might lift their religion above the worship of the Yahuwah, and all they do is try to build a tower as in the days of Nimrod, but this one is a spiritual tower of evil. Likewise as in those days, there is much confusion among the builders, but this time they continue to try to build this one. All the while, Yah sends His message to shed some light upon the darkness they are determined to walk in. **Proverbs 12:15; “The way of a fool is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel is wise.”** The adversaries do mock, speak evil of, and profane the Sabbath, an Appointed Time of Yah, and even His Assembly, that many call church, as was done in the days of old. **Lamentations 1:7; “Jerusalem remembered in the days of her affliction and of her miseries all her pleasant things that she had in the days of old, when her people fell into the hand of the enemy, and none did help her: the adversaries saw her, and did mock at her Sabbaths.”**

Even so, the Law of Yahuwah remains forever. There is nothing that can be done, has been done, or will be done to change it. At least that’s what is written in the Word of Yah. So the call of Yahuwah is the same, yes, there are some changes or additions according to what Yahushua said as fulfillments of the Law, but that does not change it, that just adds to it. The old covenant has not been done away with, but rather enhanced or lifted up through fulfillments, and the Law of Yahuwah remains. **Hebrews 3:7-4:11 ; “Wherefore (as the Set-apart Spirit saith, To day if ye will hear his voice, Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness: When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years. Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways. So I swear in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.) Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living Elohim. But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be**

hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. For we are made partakers of the Messiah, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end; While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation. For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses. But with whom was he grieved forty years? was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness? And to whom sware he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not? Heb 3:19 So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief. Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it. For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it. For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world. For he spake in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And Elohim did rest the seventh day from all his works. And in this place again, If they shall enter into my rest. Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief: Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts. For if Joshua had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day. There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of Elohim. For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as YHWH did from his. Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.”

In all things, we are to follow after the example that Yahushua has set before us. In this, most professed Christians agree, yet they refuse to keep the Sabbath, which He did keep. **John 15:10**; “If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father’s commandments, and abide in his love.” The Sabbath, being the fourth commandment, Yahushua also did keep as he also kept all the other commandments and Appointed Times. **Luke 4:16**; “And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read.” Concerning the Sabbath, Yahuwah has this to say in His Word to us; **Isaiah 58:13-14**; “If thou turn away thy foot from the Sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my set-apart day; and call the Sabbath a delight, the set-apart of YHWH, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: Then shalt thou delight thyself in YHWH; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of YHWH hath spoken it.”

If I speak in the tongues of mortals and of angels, but do not have love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. 2 And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. 3 If I give away all my possessions, and if I hand over my body so that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. 4 Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant 5 or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; 6 it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. 7 It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 8 Love never ends. But as for prophecies, they will come to an end; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will come to an end. 9 For we know only in part, and we prophesy only in part; 10 but when the complete comes, the partial will come to an end. 11 When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child; when I became an adult, I put an end to childish ways. 12 For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then we will see face to face. Now I know only in part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known. 13 And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love. 1 Corinthians 13

CHAPTER FIVE GROWING IN LOVE

Love, in itself, has two parts to it, and it always has, and always will. The two parts can be viewed as between one person and another. The two parts are; one, to love Yahuwah your Elohim with all your heart, and two, to love your neighbor as yourself. In this is where the keeping of the commandments of Yah come into completion. **John 15:10; “If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.”**

2 Thessalonians 3:5; “And the Master direct your hearts into the love of YHWH, and into the patient waiting for the Messiah.” We should be willing for the Master Yahushua to lead us into the love of Yahuwah, by the set-apart Spirit, rather than by our own wisdom. In so doing, we must also have patience toward the reception and understanding of the truth. If we are patient, we will come to the knowledge of the truth, through a continual seeking to love Him. He will reveal Himself to those that truthfully want to know Him. Yahuwah views love as being the greatest thing that we can share. **Mark 12:33; “And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.”**

Love is the foundation upon which Yahuwah shall keep His covenant and mercy with us. This is the whole of how we may know and love Him, by keeping His commandments. **Deuteronomy 7:9; “Know therefore that YHWH thy Elohim, he is Elohim, the faithful El, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments**

to a thousand generations;” Again, I must stress the fact that we cannot have this love, or obey the commandments of Yahuwah of ourselves, but only through the set-apart Spirit can we do so. **1 Peter. 1:22-23; “Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of YHWH, which liveth and abideth for ever.”**

This chapter would not be complete without the mention of **1 Corinthians 13**, which is commonly known as "The love chapter" among several different groups of the assembly. This chapter gives a very good description of love, the kind of love that is Messiah-like. This is the kind of love that Yahushua showed us on a daily basis, continually, while He was with us in fleshly form, on Earth. It is the example of the kind of love we are to walk in, not the selfish kind of love that the people of this world has. For those that are not familiar with this chapter, a recommendation to read it is good advice. **Colossians 3:12-14; “Put on therefore, as the elect of YHWH, set-apart and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as the Messiah forgave you, so also do ye. And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.”** This passage is talking about the Messiah-like love described in **1 Corinthians 13**. We should seek to be vessels of this kind of love, and cause others to want to follow after this kind of love. **Hebrews 10:24; “And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:” 1 John 3:18; “My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth.”** This is in reference to the commandments of Yah, to walk in the fullness of love.

Romans 13:8-10; “Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law. For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.”

Here we see second commandment as Yahushua said, in that it covers the last six of the Ten Commandments. The two commandments that Yahushua gave us summarize the Ten Commandments to better understanding. **Galatians 5:13-14; “For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another. For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.”** This covers all the Law of Yah towards our fellow man.

In dealing with our neighbor, we must consider what can be done to help this person, without offending them in the process of doing so. We need to let all that we do be done with love.

1 Corinthians 16:14; “Let all your things be done with love.” So then, when we see a chance to work in love towards our neighbor, we ought to be filled with joy that we might be able to do something for them. **Galatians 6:10 “As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.”**



CHAPTER SIX THE DECEPTON OF FALSE RELIGION

The world religion, mentioned earlier, follows after the master plan of deception that is spoken of in the books of Revelation and Daniel. These two books within the Word of Yah describe in much detail the beast, and his works in these last days. The beast spoken of is a church of this world. This church has been in existence since the Roman empire began. Take note; these are the same people that carried out the request that our Master Yahushua should be crucified. This is what the Word of Yah calls the great whore that sitteth upon many waters, and the Mother of Harlots in the book of Revelation. I choose not to name names any further than already mentioned, but rather, let the Word of Yah reveal who this "mother church" is. The books mentioned above, in the Word of Yahuwah, give a clear description of her characteristics. Her, and her offspring have more in common than some of them care to admit. **Matt. 15:8-9; "This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me. But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men."**

Mark 7:5-9 "Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashed hands? He answered and said unto them, Well hath Isaiah prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men. For laying aside the commandment of YHWH, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do. And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of YHWH, that ye may keep your own tradition." Here we see a specific instance where it appears as an attempt to impose their own tradition, doctrine, or commandment upon Yahushua and His disciples. His response was very simple and straight to the point, establishing the *reason* such doctrines,

traditions, or commandments are without merit. Such is a very similar doctrine, or “commandment” of man, in that what appears to be a direct attempt to change the “work” commandment.

The “washing of pots and cups and many other such like things” would appear to be work. There is only one commandment in the Ten Commandments that deals with work, the fourth of the Ten Commandments testifies against the doing of work on the seventh day Sabbath. Now here is the truth of the matter; the seventh day of the week is not Saturday or Sunday, because it does not fall on the 6 days of work and seventh day rest *after* the new moon day. Many are they that teach for doctrines that the Sabbath is no longer to be observed, but rather the first day according to the Gregorian calendar, Sunday, in remembrance of the resurrection, nailed to the stake, or whatever other reason they may have for an excuse. Nowhere in the Word of Yah can be found any authorization, or commandment, or change of the Sabbath from the seventh day to the first day, or that it was abolished at Calvary.

Paul, in the 24th chapter of Acts, was brought before a governor, and accused of doing things against their laws of religion. They accused him of being a ringleader of a sect, and of heresy. This is the *only* time you will find the heresy used in the entire Word of Yahuwah. Know this; a sect is a group of people who have broken away from an established church, and heresy is the rejection of a belief that is a part of church dogma, and/or a religious belief opposed to the orthodox doctrines of a church, especially such a belief specifically denounced by the church. Paul had this to say to his accusers **Acts 24:14** **“But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the Elohim of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:”** They tried to accuse Paul of doing wrong in the things of Yahuwah, even as they tried to do to Yahushua. The works of evil were being made manifest in that day, and they continue to progress in evil-doing even today. The Saints of Yahuwah continue to be accused of heresy because they follow not after the ways of the world churches. Sabbatarian’s are viewed as being a peculiar people’ even by this world’s church system. There is a passage of scripture that very much resembles the days we are now living in.

Ezekiel 22:23-29; “And the word of YHWH came unto me, saying, Son of man, say unto her, Thou art the land that is not cleansed, nor rained upon in the day of indignation. There is a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst thereof, like a roaring lion ravening the prey; they have devoured souls; they have taken the treasure and precious things; they have made her many widows in the midst thereof. Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine set-apart things: they have put no difference between the set-apart and profane, neither have they shewed difference between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my Sabbaths, and I am profaned among them. Her princes in the midst thereof are like wolves ravening the prey, to shed blood, and to destroy souls, to get dishonest gain. And her prophets have daubed them with untempered mortar, seeing vanity, and divining lies unto them, saying, Thus saith the Master YHWH, when YHWH hath not spoken. The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully.”

Revelation 13 is the chapter which I like to call “the battle of religion” because it describes how the false religion, or the Devil’s religion, tries to gain supremacy over all of Yahuwah’s children. To gain a better understanding of what **Revelation 13** is talking about, we need also to read **Revelation 7:1-18**. After taking the time to read both of those chapters 7 and 13, we can see

that “the battle of religion” has been somewhat exposed, provided that some individual research is done on our own. We need to see the truth behind the great false doctrine of the world church and religious system. We have covered it to some degree already, but for the sake of some, it must be mentioned again. The first day observance (Sunday, day of the sun god) in place of the seventh day (Saturday, day of the god called Saturn) in the Gregorian calendar is a false doctrine with absolutely no biblical foundation whatsoever. There is no scriptural authority in any way, for changing the day in remembrance of the resurrection of Yahushua, or the removal of the biblical calendar, which is established by the lights in the sky, where the moon determines the months, and the sun determines the years. The Sabbath has not been “nailed to the cross” and made void as some might claim. Yahushua established the Law of Yahuwah, he did not destroy it, or abolish it in any way.

There were three sets of laws given to Moses aside from the Ten Commandments. These were kept in an outside compartment on the Ark of the Covenant. The three sets of laws were the ceremonial laws, civil laws, and the health laws. None of these laws were a witness against us. Rather, they were a witness *for* prophecies to be fulfilled, how to manage society, and how to take care of ourselves. The ceremonial laws had animal sacrifices and other such offerings, to which Yahushua was the final and only blood sacrifice required for our salvation. All of these offerings, including the animal sacrifices, were a shadow of things to come, and have, since the coming of the Messiah Yahushua, been done away with, or no longer needed, because they would make His sacrifice to no effect for us. If you want to really know what was nailed to the cross (our sins), you might want to read my document entitled “What Was Nailed to The Cross?” This “nailed to the cross” and “Saturday to Sunday in remembrance of His resurrection” doctrine are some of the main doctrines that the world church clings to, which originated from the mother church, and laid upon her offspring. The “mother church”, being the world’s leading church, and the offspring of hers, being churches that have departed from her, but still follow after some of her doctrines and commandments. In the book of Daniel, chapter seven, we get a clear picture of what the “mother church, the harlot, attempts to do, by trying to change the very calendar given to us by Yahuwah in His Word. **Daniel 7:23-25; “Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces. And the ten horns out of this kingdom are ten kings that shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings. And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.”**

Take heed to what the Word of Yahuwah says, and do not be partial in the Law, for it will be revealed in the time of judgement what has been done. We should teach and preach the Law of Yahuwah, as well as the salvation and faith of Yahushuwah. **Malachi 2:7-10 “For the priest’s lips should keep knowledge, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he is the messenger of YHWH of hosts. But ye are departed out of the way; ye have caused many to stumble at the law; ye have corrupted the covenant of Levi, saith YHWH of hosts. Therefore have I also made you contemptible and base before all the people, according as ye have not kept my ways, but have been partial in the law. Have we not all one father? hath not one El created us? why do we deal treacherously every man against his brother, by profaning the covenant of our fathers?”**

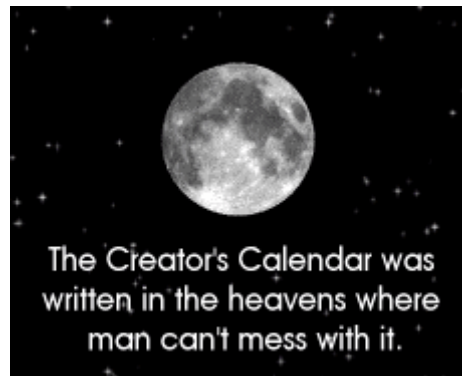
Romans 9:27-33; “Isaiah also crieth concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be saved: For he will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness: because a short work will YHWH

make upon the earth. And as Isaiah said before, Except YHWH Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha. What shall we say then? That the Gentiles, which followed not after righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness which is of faith. But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness. Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone; As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.”

According to the above scripture, though the people of Yahuwah are in such great number, only a few remaining faithful to the commandments of Yahuwah, and the testimony of Yahushua shall be saved. Even so, the world will continue to try to walk in its t own ways until the appointed time, and even try to convince us that the ways in which it walks is the true and correct way; they will be convinced in their own minds, preaching another gospel and messiah. **2 Pet. 2:1-2 “But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Master that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. And many shall follow their destructive ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of.”** Think about what calendar you keep, and if it really stays within the truth of Yahuwah, and if it really proclaims or denies the true Messiah. Let’s look at a couple of passages concerning the Law of Yah. **Matthew 22:36-40; “Rabbi, which is the great commandment in the law? Yahushua said unto him, Thou shalt love YHWH thy Elohim with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.”** And now **Mark 12:28-31 “And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all? And Yahushua answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; YHWH is our Elohim, YHWH is one: And thou shalt love YHWH thy Elohim with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.”** Do not be fooled by them that try to use these passages as an excuse to disregard the Ten Commandments of Yah. The two “great commandments” are the Ten Commandments of Yahuwah *simplified*. The commandments of Yah are summarized and fulfilled in keeping the two “great commandments”.

The first four of the Ten Commandments are between Yahuwah and man, and the last six are between man and his neighbor. Yah has fulfilled the New Covenant promise to us by putting His Law in our heart, which does not nullify or make void His Law, but rather makes it all the more to be observed and kept (by the grace of Yahuwah, and power of the set-apart Spirits) in us. **Hebrews 8:7-10; “For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith YHWH, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith YHWH. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith YHWH; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them Elohim, and they shall be to me a people:”**

To all people, concerning the Law of Yahuwah, our Master and Messiah, Yahushua has said in **Matt. 5:17-19**; **“Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled. Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.”**



CHAPTER SEVEN HIS WAYS, HIS DAYS

Here we are finally. We are now at a point where we really *need to understand* about His Ways, and His Days. We have caught a glimpse of what the “great whore that sits on many waters” attempts to do in changing the days and Appointed Times of Yahuwah, by trying to change His Calendar for us completely, thinking to change both times and laws in doing so. This attempted “change” stands with absolutely zero authority over the Laws and Word of Yahuwah, and actually *denies* both Yahuwah and His Son, and our Messiah, Yahushua. This is the *creeping compromise* and great deception that attempts to fool even the very elect of Yah. This is the conspiracy that the Devil and his cohorts have devised in an attempt to undermine everything which directs worship to Yahuwah, and cause wonder, or worship to the beast and his image.

Psalms 81:10-13; **“I am YHWH thy Elohim, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it. But my people would not hearken to my voice; and Israel would none of me. So I gave them up unto their own hearts' lust: and they walked in their own counsels. Oh that my people had hearkened unto me, and Israel had walked in my ways!”** Yahuwah cries out to His children as a Father does, pleading with them to hear His wisdom, knowing what is the right thing to do, and they simply rebel against Him, too ignorant or stubborn to understand their danger. **Psalms 95:3-11**; **“For YHWH is a great El, and a great King above all elohim. In his hand are the deep places of the earth: the strength of the hills is his also. The sea is his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry land. O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before YHWH our maker. For he is our Elohim; and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. To day if ye will hear his voice, Harden not your heart, as in the provocation, and as in the day of temptation in the wilderness: When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my work. Forty years long was I grieved with this generation, and said, It is a people that do err in their heart, and they have not known my ways: Unto whom I swear in my wrath that they should not enter into my rest.”**

Yahuwah proved to become quite angry with us for not entering into the rest He appointed for us, knowing that not only would it truly give us rest, but is also basically speaking, a “missed appointment” to meet with our Father in prayer, praise and worship, leaving Him without our love for Him, even though our love is no comparison to His love for us. **Isaiah 55:6-9; “Seek ye YHWH while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near: Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto YHWH, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our Elohim, for he will abundantly pardon. For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith YHWH. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.”** Just like a Father will tell his child; “Listen to me, because I know what is right for you, I know that was wrong, and it’s ok since you asked me to forgive you, just listen to me because I am trying to protect you out of my love for you, if you will let me.”

Why is it so hard for some of us to see how much He really loves us? He has done all He can do, even to the extent of coming in the flesh form as His Son and dying for us that we might be saved. All we have to do is take the Master’s hand, and follow Him. He will lead us in the path that we need to walk, and not stumble. With Him, even if we do stumble, He’s there to pick us up, and set us right again, if we look to Him for His love and help. There will come a time when He can’t do that anymore, and His hand will be forced to deal the consequences of not listening to Him. That is when His Son, and our Messiah will have to do what I know they do not want to do, but must do in order to make those that are His completely safe again, entering into His Kingdom, where there is no more pain, sorrow, suffering or death.

That scripture in Isaiah is also repeated again with even more emphasis telling us to “hold onto His hand and don’t let go” in **Hebrews 3:1-12 “Wherefore, set-apart brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, the Messiah Yahushua; Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house. For this man was counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath builded the house hath more honour than the house. For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is Elohim. And Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after; But the Messiah as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end. Wherefore (as the Set-apart Spirit saith, To day if ye will hear his voice, Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness: When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years. Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways. So I swear in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.) Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living Elohim.”**

We have the basic understanding that “Father knows best” just from what has been shown here so far, so let’s now take a look at the issue of the attempted change to His Appointed Times and Laws. To do this, the first thing we need to understand is what He established as the calendar for us to observe. While many of us know the story of creation in Genesis, there is also something many may have missed in the significance or importance of in that very first chapter; **Genesis 1:14-15; “And Elohim said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for**

days, and years: And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so.” The key verse here is verse 14. This verse is the very first part of establishing the “Biblical Calendar” of Yahuwah. The lights in the sky are for signs, and they determine the seasons, days, and years. Seasons, in this scripture properly translated or transliterated is the Hebrew word, mo’ed (H4150), (from ya’ad H3259) meaning; properly an *appointment*, that is, a fixed *time* or season; specifically a *festival*; conventionally a *year*; by implication, an *assembly* (as convened for a definite purpose); technically the *congregation*; by extension, the *place of meeting*; also a *signal* (as appointed beforehand): - appointed (sign, time), (place of, solemn) assembly, congregation, (set, solemn) feast, (appointed, due) season, solemn (-ity), synagogue, (set) time (appointed). Simply translated, it means Appointed Times.

It cannot be any more easy or simple than that to see that the calendar Yahuwah intended for us to follow was first established right at the beginning of creation, with the very first Appointed Time also being established... the Fourth Commandment, which also happens to put His Seal on those that belong to Him, the exact opposite of the “mark of the beast” in which the world mother church has claimed is their authority over the Word of Yahuwah, by attempting to change the solemnity of the Sabbath from one day to another, but what they do not tell you is they also attempted to change the entire calendar, which *is* the image of the beast that the whole world worships.

To better understand this worship, let’s define worship according to the Merriam-Webster Dictionary;

“Full Definition of WORSHIP

1

chiefly British : a person of importance —used as a title for various officials (as magistrates and some mayors)

2

: reverence offered a divine being or supernatural power; *also* : an act of expressing such reverence

3

: a form of religious practice with its creed and ritual

4

: extravagant respect or admiration for or devotion to an object of esteem <*worship* of the dollar>”

Definition 4 hits the nail right on the head so to speak, in that it *identifies* the fact we already know, in that some *objects* can, have been, and are being worshipped as with respect to, or devotion to it. Now how might you feel if the Gregorian calendar was suddenly “yanked away” from all the world? How would you know when to do what it is you normally do? More importantly, how would you find the Sabbath, or any other of Yahuwah’s Appointed Times? That is exactly what will happen one day, and without that Gregorian calendar, and being on your own with no help, there is only one way to find the Sabbath, or any other of the Appointed Times... The calendar established by Yahuwah. **Isaiah 66:22-23**; “**For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith YHWH, so shall your seed and your name remain. And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith YHWH.**”

From one new moon to another, translated another way, but still having the exact same meaning is this: From one new month to another. Within the scriptures, there are four types of days. New moon days, Sabbath days, set-apart or feast days, and work days. There is no way around this, as it was set from the beginning, and is reproved within the Word of Yahuwah multiple times over and over, and is also showing as still being observed in the new heavens and Earth in the verse above, not even mentioning other verses that reprove this fact. We can find the first month of the year established in **Exodus 12:1-2** “**And YHWH spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.**” We can also find His Appointed Times or feasts (the Sabbath is also called a Feast) listed in **Leviticus 23**, and at the very beginning it is made very clear who’s Appointed Times or Feasts these are: **Leviticus 23:1-2** “**And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of YHWH, which ye shall proclaim to be set-apart convocations, even these are my feasts.**”

Let’s keep in mind one simple fact in that we know both Yahuwah and His Son Yahushua do not change, so that means His Appointed Times do not change either. He even repeatedly says in Leviticus that the statutes of the Feasts are to be kept forever. So, now we have a completely different calendar from the Gregorian, with the *true* set-apart days, otherwise known as “Holy Days, or “holidays” as they are called in the Gregorian *counterfeit* calendar. This Gregorian *counterfeit* calendar attempts to replace all of the set-apart days or Appointed Times of Yahuwah, thereby denying our Creator, and His Son, and all that is sacred in the faith of such. It also incorporates pagan other mighty ones, or “gods” by months and days names and worship festivals, coercing us to call on such names, when we are specifically told not to do that within Yahuwah’s word in the Second Commandment, and directly by names in **Exodus 23:13** “**And in all things that I have said unto you be circumspect: and make no mention of the name of other elohim, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth.**”

CHAPTER EIGHT
CALLING OF HIS PEOPLE

Our ha'Mashiach Yahushua spoke many great words in His teachings. He seemed to say things with much deeper meaning than what they appeared to be about. Such is the case as in **Matthew 6:33**; **“But seek ye first the kingdom of Elohim, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”** As always, the words in which He spoke, when led by the Qodesh Ruach (set-apart Spirit), can lead us into the deep things of Yahuwah. This passage of scripture is much more wisdom to them that receive it without reserve, to the whole of its' meaning. First, in all that we do, we should seek the Kingdom of Yah, and His righteousness. This is a big part of His calling to those that follow Him.

The kingdom of Yahuwah is the first thing mentioned, so we need to know what the Kingdom of Elohim is. **Romans 14:17**; **“For the kingdom of YHWH is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Set-apart Spirit.”** So now that we have an idea of what the Kingdom of YHWH is, we have need to know what righteousness is. Seeing that the set-apart Spirit is our guide in all these things, what is righteousness? Already we see that it plays a big part in the Kingdom of Yah because it is mentioned so much. The songs of David are of the most beautiful songs ever written (I personally like **Psalms 19:7-10**). The clearest definition to what righteousness is, can be found in **Psalms 119:172** **“My tongue shall speak of thy word: for all thy commandments are righteousness.”** The Ten Commandments are the Righteousness of Yahuwah, to which we are called. We are to observe, keep, and speak of the Commandments of Yahuwah even as we speak of our Master Yahushua.

2 Cor. 5:20-21; **“Now then we are ambassadors for the Messiah, as though Elohim did beseech you by us: we pray you in the Messiah's stead, be ye reconciled to YHWH. For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of YHWH in him.”** In this sense, we should be as the words given through David in **Psalms 40:8-10**; **“I delight to do thy will, O my Elohim: yea, thy law is within my heart. I have preached righteousness in the great congregation: lo, I have not refrained my lips, O YHWH, thou knowest. I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy loving kindness and thy truth from the great congregation.”** Even more as in **Ecclesiastes 12:13-14**; **“Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear Elohim, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For Elohim shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.”**

Psalms 9:8; **“And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.”** Those that are of this world, even this world religion, view the Righteousness of Yahuwah as foolishness. They have, and still do try to justify their own way of understanding or religion as being the right way, some even claiming to be the only way. Yahuwah has something to say about all this: **1 Corinthians 1:26-31**; **“For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: But YHWH hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and YHWH hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath YHWH chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: That no flesh should glory in his presence. But of him are ye in the Messiah Yahushua, who of YHWH is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in YHWH.”**

We will come across the path of those who stand in opposition of Yahuwah, or His Law, and seem to be unable to persuade them to righteousness. We might even suffer persecution from them, but we must continue to fight the good fight of faith. Keep planting seeds of righteousness, and with trust in Yaah, we may know that things will work according to His plan, and perhaps one of those seeds will take root and grow to bear fruit. **Romans 8:28; “And we know that all things work together for good to them that love YHWH, to them who are the called according to his purpose.”** Here is even more concerning the issue in **John 15:14-22; “Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his master doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you. Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you. These things I command you, that ye love one another. If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you. If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you. Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his master. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also. But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not him that sent me. If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin: but now they have no cloke for their sin.”**

There are many that are called to follow after our Messiah, Yahushua, and from these are the ones that are the chosen of Yahuwah. **Matthew 20:16; “So the last shall be first, and the first last: for many be called, but few chosen.”** **John 6:37; “All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.”** **John 6:44; “No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.”** Many claim to be in fellowship with Yahuwah, but fail to walk after the set-apart Spirit of Yah to the knowledge of the truth. **Romans 8:1-10 “There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in the Messiah Yahushua, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Messiah Yahushua hath made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, YHWH sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Rom 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against YHWH: for it is not subject to the law of YHWH, neither indeed can be. So then they that are in the flesh cannot please YHWH. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of YHWH dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of the Messiah, he is none of his. And if the Messiah be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.”**

Not only do some that are called fail to walk after the Spirit of Yahuwah, but they are a rebellious people. They refuse the Law of Yah that they might hear only what they want to hear, walk in the ways that they want to, and teach others to do the same. **Isaiah 30:1; “Woe to the rebellious children, saith YHWH, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit, that they may add sin to sin:”** and **Isaiah 30: 9-**

11; “That this is a rebellious people, lying children, children that will not hear the law of YHWH: Which say to the seers, See not; and to the prophets, Prophecy not unto us right things, speak unto us smooth things, prophesy deceits: Get you out of the way, turn aside out of the path, cause the Set-apart One of Israel to cease from before us.” And yet again in **2 Timothy 3:1-9**; **“This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unset-apart, Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of YHWH; Having a form of reverence, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts, Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith. But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was.”**

Now as Jannes and Janbres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith. **“But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be made manifest unto all men, as theirs also was.”** There are many in the world today that might fit the description of what we have just read, and it is this type of people that bring persecution against the true followers of Yahushua. There is much persecution that will come against the church in these last days, and it will come from this world's religious system. The “mother church” leads this world's offspring churches in the great persecution of the Saints of Yahuwah.

1 Peter 4:12-19; **“Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you: But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Messiah's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy. If ye be reproached for the name of Messiah, happy are ye; for the spirit of glory and of YHWH resteth upon you: on their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified. But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters. Yet if any man suffer as a Messiahian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify YHWH on this behalf. For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of YHWH: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of YHWH? And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the wicked and the sinner appear? Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of YHWH commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.”**



CHAPTER NINE THE FINAL CHOICE

Rev. 18:1-5; “And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory. And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird. For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies. And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues. For her sins have reached unto heaven, and YHWH hath remembered her iniquities.”

In these last days Yah is calling out to His people, to come out of the world church religion. Satan is the “god” of this world, and the world religion is full of his deceptions. Those following this world's religion are walking blindly in the darkness of this world, and “if the blind lead the blind, will they not both fall into the ditch”? Yahuwah calls out because there are some of His people within this world's religious system that have not yet come to the knowledge of the truth. The Light shines through the darkness for a time, and then there shall be a time such as the world has never seen before. No secret rapture will take place, because there is no need of one. When the King and Master Yahushua ha'Machiach returns, all will know it. No one will be able to hide, or be in some position to miss it. He is waiting for His people to come out of Babylon, which I believe is the spiritual confusion that has taken over this world through a creeping compromise and deception.

Revelation 7:1-3; “And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree. And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living Elohim: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea, Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our Elohim in their foreheads.” Is it possible that this “seal” spoken of here is the very seal of Yahuwah by the true Sabbath, according to the Biblical Calendar, or maybe it could be the seal of knowing His name, because both of these scenarios are actually *in* our

foreheads, because that's where our main thought process occurs, in the frontal lobe right behind the forehead of the skull.

We should pay close attention to the words of our Savior Yahushua, that we might understand the things now taking place and soon to take place. **Matthew 24:3-31**; **“And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world? And Yahushua answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am the Messiah; and shall deceive many. And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows.**

Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another. And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the set-apart place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:) Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains: Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house: Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes. And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days! But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the Sabbath day: For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is the Messiah, or there; believe it not. For there shall arise false messiahs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. Behold, I have told you before. Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; believe it not. For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together. Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.”

With all that we have come to understand (Yahuwah willing), we should hear what he says to the churches; **Revelation 2:4-5**; “Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.” And again going back to **Luke 16:15-18**; “And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but YHWH knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of YHWH. The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of YHWH is preached, and every man presseth into it. And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail.” Remember the Father’s love for his child, and take no offense at what He says, but rather understand this is for you out of His love for you. **Revelation. 3:19-20**; “As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.”

We need to hear the call to come out of Babylon, and to keep the Commandments of Yahuwah, including His Appointed Times, and the faith of Yahushua. **Revelation 14:12**; “Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of YHWH, and the faith of Yahushua.” **1 John 2:3-5**; “And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.”

Psalms 1:1-3 “Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the wicked, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of YHWH; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.”

Psalms 119:1-2; “Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of YHWH. Blessed are they that keep his testimonies, and that seek him with the whole heart.”

If we are as the Saints of Yahuwah, the remnant seed of the true Assembly of Yahushua, this world’s religious system will not accept us as speaking truth for them. They will speak evil of us, and even persecute us, because they walk in the darkness of this world, and think that their “way” is right. **Revelation 12:17**; “And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of YHWH, and have the testimony of Yahushua the Messiah.”

The victory over the enemy, the final victory, will come in the presence of our Messiah Yahushua, so do not give up hope, but rather look for His appearance.

Ezekiel 20:19-20; “I am YHWH your Elohim; walk in my statutes, and keep my judgments, and do them; And hallow my Sabbaths; and they shall be a sign between me and you, that ye may know that I am YHWH your Elohim.”

Deut. 11:18; “Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes.”

Exodus 13:9; “And it shall be for a sign unto thee upon thine hand, and for a memorial between thine eyes, that YHWH's law may be in thy mouth: for with a strong hand hath YHWH brought thee out of Egypt.”

Rev. 22:14; “Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.”
